What are our responsibilities?

Staff are required to report any **issues** or **signs** that a student is **unsafe**.

Staff will aim to keep young people **aware** of the dangers of extremist views.

Staff will question any **wrongful beliefs** that go against our British Values.

Staff will keep an eye on **changes** in students behaviour.

Staff will question any **violent** or **hateful** comments.
