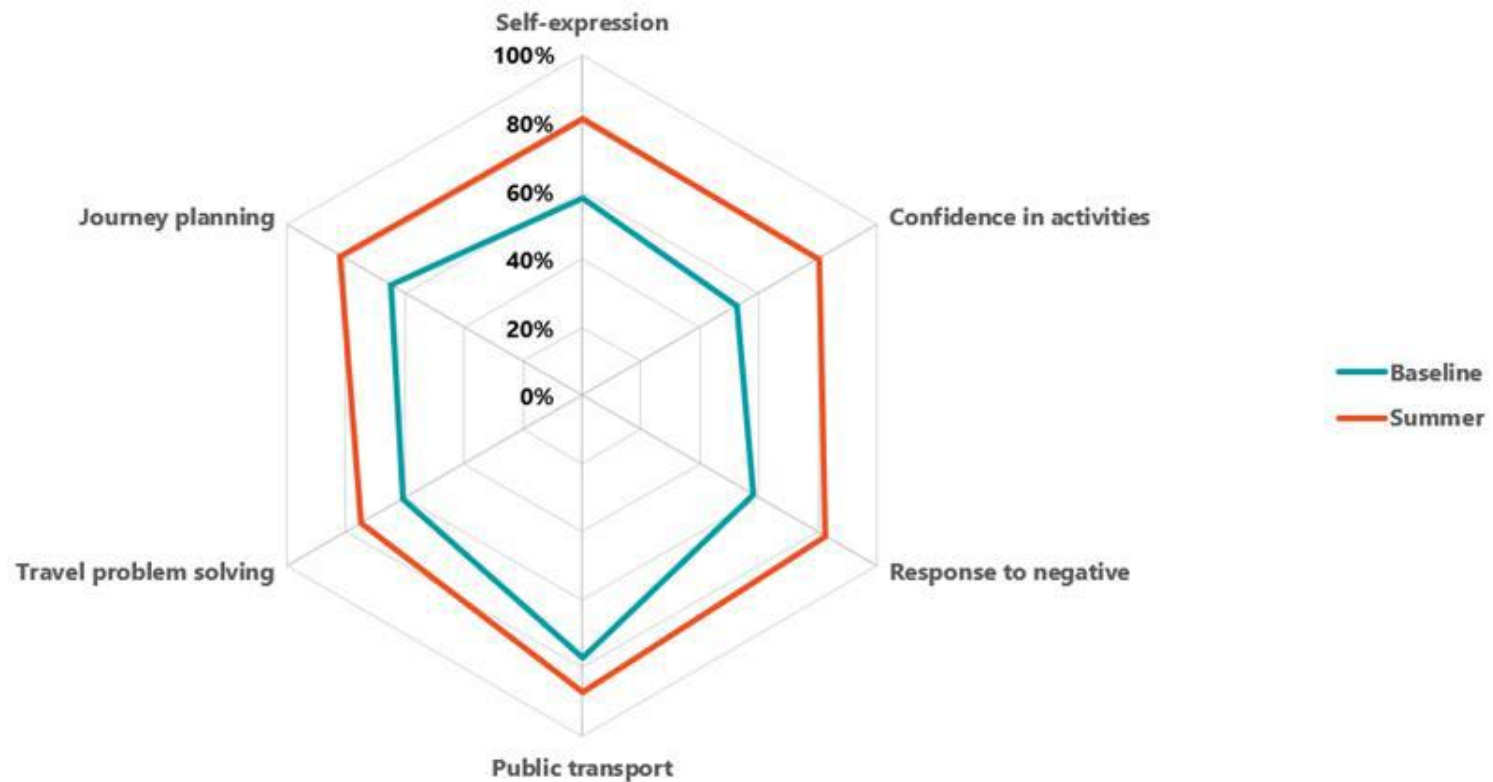

Student Surveys and Feedback - summary

In student surveys learners were asked the following:

Questions:	Data from survey:
Do you feel that TAP is providing enough opportunities to socialise with your friends on The Autism Project by using platforms such as WhatsApp and Zoom?	100% said yes, they feel they have enough opportunities to socialise
Do you feel that you are supported enough with your well-being by TAP staff?	66.67% of learners said they feel either support a great deal or a lot by TAP staff
Do you feel you have developed any independent skills since being in lockdown?	73.33% said yes, they do feel they have developed independent skills
Did you get the right support you needed to do your best?	50% said yes, almost always 36% said most of the time
Do you feel that you are supported enough by TAP staff to complete tasks and activities?	93.33% learners said that they feel supported
Do you feel you have enough regular contact with TAP staff during the lockdown?	93.3% said yes they do have enough contact
