What are our responsibilities?

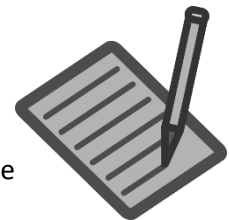
If a student **does not follow a rule** in the **classroom agreement** and their **student contract**:

1. A staff member will **tell them what they have done**, and they will be reminded to **not do it again**.



2. If the student does do it again, they will be given a **verbal warning**.

3. If the student continues to break the rules, they will be given a **written warning**.



4. If they still break the rules a **final warning** will be given, and a **meeting** will be held to discuss the behaviour.

5. After the meeting, the student will either **continue the project with a behaviour plan** or they will be **leave TAP**.
